THE GOLDEN RULES

- 1 **SLOW DOWN.** Real banks, family & the Sheriff **never** rush you. Feeling rushed **is** the alarm bell.
- 2 **HANG UP. LOOK IT UP. CALL BACK** on a number **you** find — not the one they gave you.
- 3 **NO GIFT CARDS. EVER.** No real company or agency is ever paid in gift cards. That alone = **SCAM.**
- 4 **NOBODY CONTROLS YOUR COMPUTER** in secret. Real help never takes hidden control.
- 5 **WHEN IN DOUBT, ASK FIRST.** Call before you click, download, or pay.

IT'S A SCAM IF...

- ❑ They say “**act NOW**” or you’ll lose money or get arrested.
- ❑ They want **gift cards, wire, Zelle, or crypto.**
- ❑ They tell you to **keep it secret.**
- ❑ They want to **take over your computer.**
- ❑ They say “**verify your account**” with a link.
- ❑ It’s an **unexpected caller** — a grandchild in trouble, a “deputy,” a toll you owe.
- ❑ They say “**move your money to a safe account.**” No real bank ever says this.

One YES is enough. Stop and call Jeffery.

3 Questions to Ask Any Caller

1. “**What is your name and company?**” — then hang up.
